FROM THE MAYOR

In many ways 2020 has been a tumultuous year for Ku-ring-gai and our nation as we emerge from the COVID-19 lockdown. I want to thank all our residents for the sacrifices made in order to flatten the curve and protect vulnerable members of our community.



During this time our Council has offered support by moving services online, suspending a range of fees for businesses and distributing \$80,000 in grants to community organisations.

COVID-19 has also caused the postponement of NSW Local Government elections due this September to September 2021.

Despite the pandemic's effects, we have completed or commenced work on a number of projects outlined in this newsletter.

Work on revitalising Lindfield is gathering pace, with the Lindfield Village Green in Tryon Road well underway and tenders for the Lindfield Village Hub being evaluated for a decision by Council. The planning proposal for the Hub has been approved by Council to be assessed by the NSW Department of Planning.

Lindfield Village Hub

The Hub will be a mix of green space, new housing and community buildings including a library and community centre on the western side of Lindfield centre. The Council has endorsed the Hub's planning proposal be submitted for state government approval and the tender assessment was reported to Councillors in June 2020.

Gordon streetscapes

We're upgrading St Johns Avenue, Henry Street, Wade Lane up to Park Avenue and Werona Avenue to increase opportunities for outdoor dining and make the area more attractive to visit. Works will begin in the 2021 - 2022 financial year.

Lindfield Village Green

The Village Green will transform the public car park at Tryon Road into a new community space that could feature outdoor dining, markets and music. The development is expected to open early next year and will feature three levels of short and long stay parking underground.
