 - be insured with workers compensation, public liability and professional indemnity insurance
 - provide a written quote that includes business ABN, contact details, detail of works, and costs
 - explain how they will do the job safely.

Travelling conmen and complaints

- Protect yourself from travelling conmen. Be suspicious of people who:
 - turn up unexpectedly offering special one-off or today-only deals
 - ask for cash up-front
 - offer to drive you to the bank to get money for payment
 - pressure you into accepting their offer
 - disappear and leave the job unfinished or in a poor standard.
