

APPLICATION FOR SECTION 126 HOARDINGS AND BARRICADES ON FOOTPATH

IMPORTANT

Please read the following information prior to lodging your request for a Section 126; Hoardings and Barricades on Footpath Approval online.

This guide provides information that will enable applicants to identify the plans and supporting documentation needed to apply online.

Council will not accept your application if you fail to provide all the relevant documentation.

DOCUMENTS

The plans and documents must be accurate and legible. Any misleading details may result in the refusal of the application.

The plans shall:

- 1. Have dimensions in metric.
- 2. Be to scale of 1:100 or other readily legible scale.
- 3. Show the subject site; adjoin sites, the kerb, all other Council street furniture, planters, signs, power poles, street lighting and trees/shrubs and the area propped for the activity.
- 4. Show the dimensions of the length of the subject site, the width of the footpath, the area proposed to be used and the dimension for unobstructed pedestrian access.
- 5. Show all public utilities that may be located within the proposed area of use.
- 6. Show distances from nearest intersection.
- 7. Indicate location and direction of focus of any lighting associated with the activity.
- 8. Show elevations of the hoarding/barricade detailing the materials and dimensions and slope of the footpath.
- 9. Show proposed method of anchor/support of the hoarding/barricade.

The supporting material and documentation:

- 1. The Public Liability Insurance policy to be provided shall cover the proposed use and include Ku-ring-gai Council on the policy so that Council is indemnified for claims arising from the area.
- 2. Submit photographs of any pre-existing damage to footway/road in and adjacent to the proposed area of use.
- 3. Submit a traffic management plan for the control of vehicles and pedestrians at the point of entry to the site.

Statement of environmental effects (uses/attendances/noise):

- 1. Provide details of how the proposed use is in the public interest.
- 2. Provide details as to the scope and surface conditions of the area proposed to be used and how the area is appropriate for the intended use.
