



Terms and Conditions – Kids and Teens (updated 14/07/2022)

Bookings - General

- All Art Centre classes can be subject to change.
- Hardcopy and electronic programs may at times not be up to date. Please check website or contact the Art Centre for most recent scheduling.
- It is the responsibility of the person making the booking to read the Terms and Conditions. This includes bookings made online, in person and over the phone.
- Everyone has the opportunity to enrol in different courses each term with no priority bookings. To guarantee a spot in a class over two terms in the same semester, you still have the two-term booking option available for each semester which if selected means 10% off the second term.
- No shared bookings. Only students enrolled may attend the course.
- Students who book a Full Semester ticket must remain enrolled in that course for the semester. No changes allowed for the second term. Prior to booking, student must be sure they are enrolling on the correct course at the correct ticket type. No change of mind. Any additional adjustments outside this term and condition will incur a fee.
- Tickets purchased as one term only cannot be changed to the ticket type 'Full Semester
 with 10% off the second term'. Customers who would like to continue with the second
 term in the same semester can book for the second term when enrolment opens for the
 second term.
- Cost of bookings for term courses made from Week 3 onwards are prorated and will incur
 a \$25 late fee.
- All courses are pending class numbers. This will be confirmed up to two working days prior
 to the course starting, however your enrolment in the course is confirmation of your
 booking and there are no change of mind refunds for bookings. If a course does not run,
 your account will be credited for the amount of the course.
- All students, tutors and visitors are to follow COVID-19 physical distancing, hygiene instructions and signage provided by Council and Art Centre staff. See COVID-19 Precautions below.

Bookings – Kids/Teens

- Where appropriate, don't forget to provide lunch and a snack (no nut products) and wear clothing that withstands paint, ink, clay or glue. Shoes must have enclosed toe and heel no thongs or sandals.
- The Art Centre practices a policy of **no nuts or nut products.** Please ensure foods brought to the Centre do not contain nuts or nut products.
- You must inform the Art Centre office at the time of booking if the child has any allergies
 (including but not limited to asthma and/or anaphylaxis), medical conditions or
 requirements for persons with a disability. The Art Centre is not able to cater to students

- who have severe medical conditions and may not be able to accommodate for all requirements. If you are unsure, please contact the Art Centre with any queries.
- The Art Centre must be notified in advance (at the time of booking) if the child has an Epipen, puffer/inhaler or any form of medication. If the child has an Action Plan it must also be emailed to the Art Centre at least two days prior to attending class.
- A student will be refused into class if their Epi-pen and/or puffer is not with them or is out
 of date. If an Action Plan is required and not provided to the Art Centre, the child cannot
 attend the class.
- Two separate phone emergency contacts must be provided in case of an emergency.
- Ku-ring-gai Art Centre accepts no responsibility for children before/after classes. There are
 no child-minding facilities available and children attending classes must be collected at the
 conclusion of the class. Parents or guardians must sign the child in and out at the beginning
 and end of each class.
- If the child is enrolled in a select teen course and if the parent/guardian gives permission for the teen to arrive to class and/or depart from class without a parent/guardian accompanying them and signing them in and out:
 - Written permission must be emailed to <u>artcentre@krg.nsw.gov.au</u> saying that the parent/guardian gives permission for the teen to either/or arrive and depart from class unaccompanied by their parent/guardian.
 - o If the Art Centre has not received written permission, the teen must continue to be accompanied by their parent/guardian and to be signed in and out by them as well.
- The Art Centre accepts no responsibility for students coming to or going from the Art Centre and any events/occurrences that may occur.
- Ku-ring-gai Art Centre accepts no children under the age of five years or children who have not yet started school. We have the right to refuse enrolments that do not meet these criteria.
- The child enrolled must be of the correct age for the course in which they enrolled. If a child has enrolled but is not of the correct age, Ku-ring-gai Art Centre reserves the right to cancel their enrolment (transfer to another course where places are available or use the cost as credit towards another course).
- Persistent unruly behaviour will not be tolerated, and a child may be asked to be removed from the class.

Transfers/Refunds

- Please choose carefully as fees are non-refundable.
- Ku-ring-gai Art Centre cannot accept responsibility for changes to students' personal circumstances that prevent attendance.
- Transfers only permitted during the same term provided places are available. If a transfer cannot be made, the fees will be credited to the parent/guardian's Bookable account.
- No transfers from the end of Week 3 onwards are permitted.
- If a course is cancelled, we will endeavour to transfer the student into another course in the same semester where places are available. If a transfer cannot be made, the fees will be credited to the parent/guardian's Bookable account.

Absenteeism

 Classes missed for personal reasons are the parent/guardian's responsibility and are nonrefundable and non-creditable.

- Students are not entitled to discounts or 'make-ups' in their own or other classes if they miss a class.
- In the event of a tutor being unable to take a class, a replacement tutor will be organised. In the case of a tutor not being available, you will be advised of a replacement class date. If a replacement class date cannot be arranged, the parent/guardian will receive the credit to their Bookable account equivalent to the cost of that class, or a refund, to be determined by the Art Centre.

Class Cancellations

- Enrolments should be made at least one week prior to commencement of the course to avoid the course being cancelled due to low enrolments.
- Courses may be cancelled if enrolment numbers are too low. If this occurs, parents/guardians will be advised by email (via Bookable) of the cancellation prior to the course commencing.
- Ku-ring-gai Art Centre does not offer refunds or transfers if a class is cancelled due to a
 tutor being ill or away. A fill-in tutor will be arranged, and if not possible, a make-up class
 will be scheduled at the end of term. If a make-up class cannot be arranged, you will
 receive the credit to your Bookable account equivalent to the cost you paid for that class,
 or a refund, to be determined by the Art Centre.
- Ku-ring-gai Art Centre reserves the right to change tutors no refunds for change of mind due to tutor replacement.

COVID-19 Precautions

- If you or the child feels unwell and/or have any symptoms of COVID-19, please do not visit the Art Centre nor attend classes.
- Art materials are not to be shared amongst students.
- All students, tutors and visitors must follow COVID-19 physical distancing regulations, hygiene instructions and signage provided by Council and Art Centre staff.
- Each parent/guardian must sign an attendance form at the START of each class and SIGN OUT at the end of each class.
