St Johns Avenue Conservation Area - C16A (KLEP 2015) & C16B (KLEP (LC) 2012)

St. Johns Avenue Conservation Area is of heritage significance for its intact Federation and Inter-war period housing, its dramatic streetscape derived from the narrow paved carriageway, wide grassed verges and mature Brushbox avenue planting. It is significant as the first paved road in Ku-ring-gai, and for its association with and the heritage significance of St. Johns Church, manse and cemetery, which encompass significant historical and social values for Ku-ring-gai. The Pacific Highway section of the HCA is of aesthetic and historical significance for its collection of fine Federation and Inter-war period housing, with some good examples of mid to late 20th century development.
