

Shirley Road Conservation Area - C38 (KLEP 2015)

The Shirley Road Conservation Area has historic significance as part of the Henry Fitzgerald and Jenkins land grants. The conservation area has historic significance as a collection of early twentieth century of subdivisions including the Shirley Road Estate (1909), Jenkins Estate (Glenearn) (1909), Jenkins Estate 1st Subdivision (1912), Lynwood Estate (1915), and a collection of Inter-war subdivisions including Recreation Park Estate (1925), Toongarah Estate (1931), Millwood Estate (DP 17798) (1936) evident in the lots and some houses. The conservation area has aesthetic significance as it is highly intact Federation and Inter-war development. Federation residences on Shirley Road have fine architectural detailing and are set in generously landscaped gardens. The type of buildings on Shirley Road range from large and notable residences, to smaller examples of both the Federation and the Inter-war periods.
