

Fernwalk Conservation Area - C9 (KLEP 2015)

The Fernwalk Heritage Conservation Area is of historical significance as an area developed from later subdivision of land once part of McKeown's land in the 19th century. The area is of aesthetic significance for its largely intact mix of Federation, Inter-war and 1940s period housing, with some mid to late twentieth century housing. The area illustrates a variety of architectural styles. The area is of historical significance for its pattern of subdivision, re-subdivision and development from the 1890s through to the 1940s.
