GENERAL INFORMATION



To ensure your bins are collected easily and safely, please follow these simple rules:

- Place your bins out for collection the night before collection day.
- Bin handles must face your house so the lids open to the street.
- Place bins half a metre apart so the truck's lifting arm can fit between the bins to pick them up.
- Make sure lids are closed – otherwise material can spill during collection.
- Do not put extra bags or bundles next to or on top of your bins. Contact Council if you have additional waste at www.krg.nsw.gov.au/waste or on 9424 0000.
- Do not place bins close to trees, cars, or under low hanging cables. This makes collection dangerous.
- Bins must not be permanently stored on the nature-strip.
- Only place acceptable items in recycling bins. Unsure? Visit www.krg.nsw.gov.au/recycling
- A weight restriction of 100kgs applies to all bins.
- For **chemical waste** disposal visit www.cleanout.com.au for the next drop-off date.
- **Needles and syringes** can be disposed of safely at participating pharmacies www.krg.nsw.gov.au/sharps
- **Community Recycling Centres** The following can be delivered for disposal free of charge: paint, batteries household & car, fluoro tubes & globes, gas bottles, fire extinguishers, motor & other oils, smoke detectors, computers, and TV's at Thornleigh and Artarmon. RECYCLING

Council's recycling collection has been designed to cater for the majority of disposable items generated in homes. However, Council is limited to collecting items that can be currently processed at recycling sorting and manufacturing facilities.

Please recycle clean paper and cardboard in the blue-lidded bin. The yellow-lidded mixed recycling bin is used to recycle glass bottles and jars, aluminium and steel cans, and disposable plastic containers from the kitchen, bathroom and laundry.

Please note: Plastic bags and polystyrene foam are NOT recyclable in Council recycling bins even though they may display a recycling symbol.

DID YOU KNOW?

- It is illegal to sweep or blow leaf matter from the nature-strip onto the road or into the gutters. This practice contributes to drainage system overload and can cause unnecessary flooding.
- Waste presented to the nature-strip without Council approval is illegal. Council runs a free cleanup service by appointment. Places are limited so book early.
