ROFE PARK POTENTIAL LISTING

BACKGROUND: The community have requested listing consideration of

Rofe Park, Turramurra.

In September 2020, the Heritage Reference Committee considered a similar request and did not resolve to progress listing assessment. The Committee then noted that the park is located with a Greenweb and biodiversity protection zone and that a heritage listing could not

really afford any additional protection.

COMMENTS: Community Group, the Friends of Mimosa Rofe Park and

Sheldon Forest have created a website that outlines the history of Rofe Park and promotes its heritage listing.

There is no heritage assessment of this site to establish listing merit. Community enjoyment or land donation alone does not meet the heritage significance threshold for listing under the NSW Heritage Council criteria.

No new information has been submitted with this latest request to demonstrate listing merit or priority for assessment. The park is protected by existing controls

and is not under threat.



Reasons for listing

The Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church is an important focal point in the Pymble area because of its prominent location on Pymble Hill. If thus forms a well-known landmark. The church is viewed travelling both north and south along the Pacific Highway where, because of the curve in the road, it constitutes the terminating point of the axial historically related to the massive Presbytery vista. The church is nearby and together make an important contribution to the streetscape. Historically both buildings also represent religious activity in the area dating back to 1863.

On 17th June, 1883, the Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church was opened on Pymble Hill. This Church was built from locally quarried sandstone and was demolished shortly before the present Church was erected.

June 9th 1907, A Presbytery Foundation Stone was laid by Cardinal Moran and t Presbytery opened later that year.

A New Church was built on the same site in 1934, the foundation stone being s by Michael Kelly, D.D. (Archbishop of Sydney) June 10th, 1934.

There is considerable evidence that the timber rafters and flooring have been

reused in the rebuilding of the Church on the same site.

The Church was designed in the Spanish style by the architectural company, Hennessy and Hennessy and was built in 1934 by Welch Brothers. Cream stucco (Pise effect) Church and bell tower. Pitched cordova church roof with tiled gables and hipped cordova roof on bell tower. Buttressed exterior walls. Yellow pre-cast Corinthian columns, with voe detailing and ornamentation above and surrounding entrance doors. Black rought from slit window grille tower cross. Low sandstone wall and black we ught from gateways along Pacific Highway, frontage of Church and Presbytery.



The Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church is an important focal point in the Municipality because of its location on Pymble Hill - a very well known landmark. The Church is viewed travelling both north and south along the Pacific Highway where, because of the curve in the road, it constitutes the terminating point of the axial vista.

A Sacred Heart Church has been associated with Pymble Hill since 1863. The building is an importance ample of the introduction of the Californian Spanish Mission Revival style to Sydney.



On June 9th, 1907, the Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church Presbytery for ation stone was laid by Cardinal Moran and the Presbytery opened later t! year. The architect of the Presbytery was Mr. Herbert Wardell who was th of the noted architect William Wilkinson Wardell, who designed both St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Cathedral in Melbourne and St. Mary's Cathedral Sydney. Hennessy and Hennessy were responsible for supervising the comp of St. Mary's to W.W. Wardell's original design.

The Presbytery, built in 1907 is two-storey and has a sandstone brick and stucco exterior, slate hipped roof with gabled front and wooden shingle detailing. Gothic style featured windows detailed by exposed brickwork Open tiled porch with timbered columns, sandstone foundations. Some additions have been done.
