Notice of Motion from Councillor T Hall dated 15 November 2010

The Ku-ring-gai Local Environmental Plan (Town Centres) 2010 came into effect on 25 May, 2010, with Council adopting the Ku-ring-gai Development Control Plan (Town Centres) 2010 on 8 June, 2010. The Ku-ring-gai Development Control Plan (DCP) provides details of the planning objectives for each of the town centres. Council now has resolved to reclassify 20 sites within the town centres from Community to Operational land, to make possible the delivery of the planning objectives detailed in the DCP. The first step in the reclassification process is now underway with the Planning Proposal on exhibition by the Ku-ring-gai Planning Panel, with Ray Street Turramurra, adopted for exhibition on 9 November 2010.

One of the most significant sites left out of the process, and indeed a group of sites, as attached in Plan 3 (a), that could lead to the most profound positive changes to the public domain in Ku-ring-gai, are Council's landholdings fronting the Village Green and providing the interface to the St Ives Shopping Village. With the adoption of the Village Green masterplan by Council earlier this year, and an anticipated program of upgrades to the Village Green over a number of years, there is a significant public benefit which could arise from the inclusion of Council's landholdings in this location in the planning and redevelopment process.

These opportunities can only be harnessed if Council's landholdings are reclassified from Community to Operational. The redevelopment of the St Ives Shopping Village in the foreseeable future provides the catalyst for new and improved public domain infrastructure and the ability to negotiate a more appropriate interface between the Shopping Village and one of Council's most important public spaces, the St Ives Shopping Village. If Council ignores this opportunity residents may have to wait another fifty years for the next redevelopment cycle to maximise the community benefits involved.

I therefore move:

A. That Council adopts the following site for the purpose of reclassification to operational land status in a new Local Environmental Plan:

- i. Lot 2 DP 822373, 11-21 Cowan Road;
- ii. Lot 1 DP 420106, 11-21 Cowan Road;
- B. That Council requests that the Ku-ring-gai Planning Panel prepares a new draft Local Environmental Plan as an amending instrument to Ku-ring-gai Local Environmental Plan (Town Centres) 2010, to list Lot 2 DP 822373, 11-21 Cowan Road and Lot 1 DP 420106, 11-21 Cowan Road to have operational land status.
