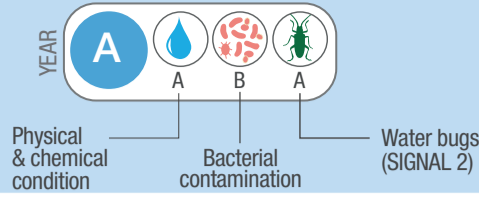

Waterway health grading

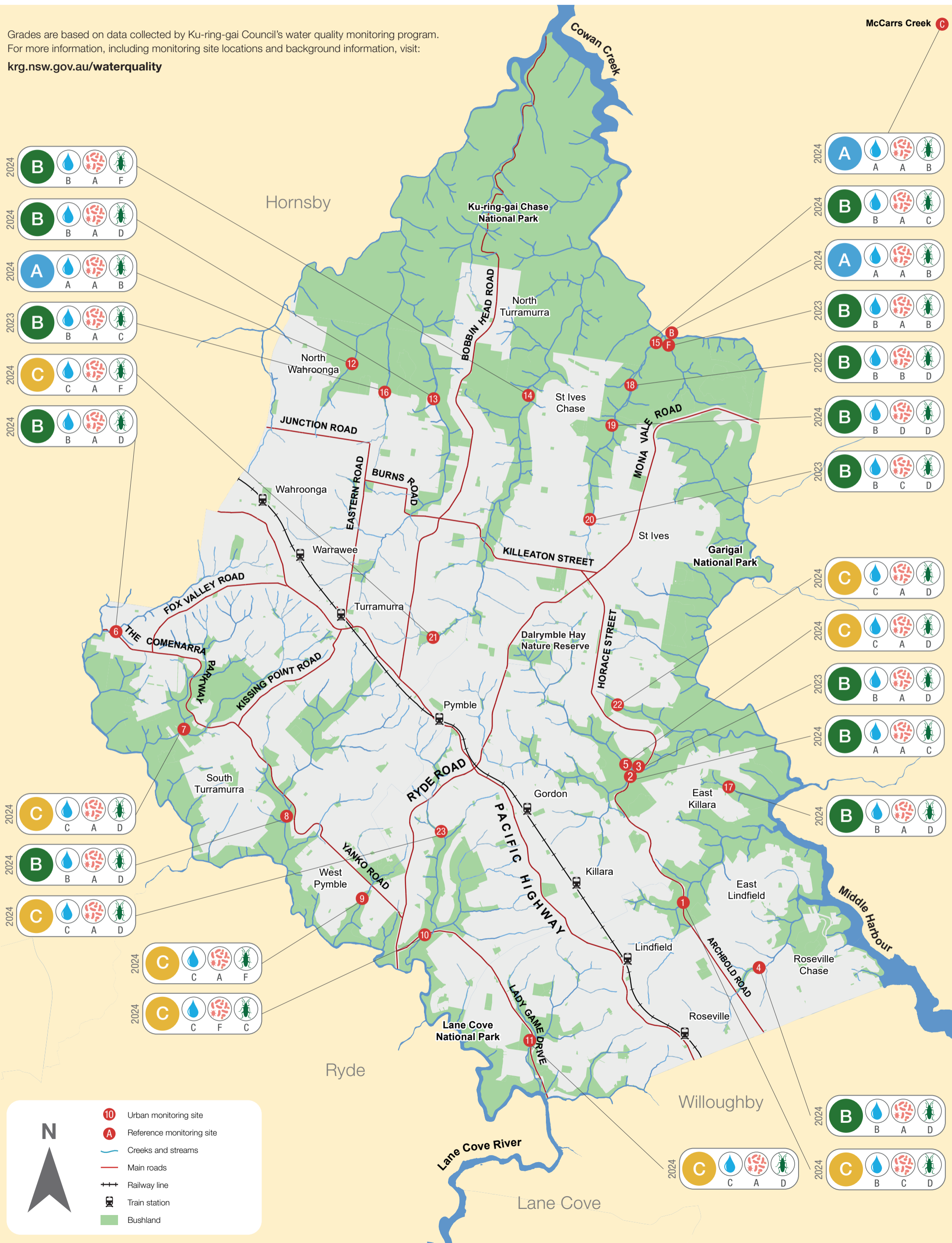


A	Excellent	Clean water and a healthy ecosystem
