Mona Vale Road - C43 (KLEP 2015)

The Mona Vale Road Conservation Area records the historical layer of subdivision of rural land used for orchards for the development of suburbs of Ku-ring-gai. The houses in the area were built from the early 1900s through to the post-war and late twentieth century, which provides a diversity of style, scale and materials. The setbacks from the street and between neighbouring houses allow for mature gardens and trees, which creates a consistent suburban context that typifies Ku-ring-gai's suburbs. These elements in combination with street trees, a high tree canopy and the relief and backdrop of mature eucalypts provide a picturesque setting.
