



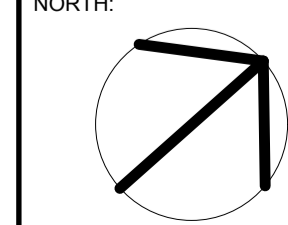

- 1** Enlarge area to create an additional playing field
- 2** Level and reconstruct playing fields with new drainage, irrigation and turf
- 3** Install floodlights on 4 playing fields for evening sports training (to finish no later than 9.30 pm) and games (to finish no later than 9.00 pm).
Traffic and parking impacts resulting from increased use of playing fields to be continually monitored and if necessary field bookings will be staggered and reduced to minimise impacts
- 4** Retain and upgrade existing 'exersite' exercise equipment
- 5** Install new fence adjacent to fields along Koola Avenue
- 6** Relocate practice cricket nets off playing field and increase from 3 to 4 nets
- 7** Relocate and expand turf cricket wicket in between playing fields
- 8** Reposition synthetic cricket wickets
- 9** Construct exercise path (minimum 2m wide) around perimeter of park for walking, jogging and cycling with links to Koola Avenue and carpark
- 10** Construct playground for older children
- 11** Realign entry road and resurface carpark (see LM03 plan for design detail)
- 12** Install water storage tanks for irrigation and recycling, with water drawn from Rocky Creek Stormwater Catchment
- 13** Disconnect septic system and connect amenities block to sewer
- 14** Remove Coral Trees for greater public safety and environmental control
- 15** Possible relocation of scout hall
- 16** Construct internal carparking and drop off zone (see LM04 plan for design detail)
- 17** No stopping along Koola Ave opposite Churchill Rd
- 18** Monitor traffic and parking safety after completion of Koola Park redevelopment and if necessary consider the installation of a median strip between Koola Park and Killara High School (See LM02 plan for more detail).
- 19** Design exercise path and sportsfield drainage system to minimise water runoff into adjacent bushland.
- 20** Consider installation of safety screen fencing if required in the future, subject to monitoring and review of the impacts following the relocation and reorientation of the existing synthetic cricket pitch.
