Macquarie Road, Pymble - Proposed 'No Stopping' restrictions on one side across crest

Council is seeking your input on a proposal to install 'No Stopping' restrictions across the crest on western side of the street, as shown on the **attached** Plan *MacquarieRd/TDA/112/25*.

Background

Council has received correspondence regarding vehicles parking along Macquarie Road, Pymble, near the vertical crest adjacent to Nos. 6 and 8.

Macquarie Road, Pymble, is a two-way local road approximately 8m wide with a vertical crest near Nos. 6 and 8. On-street parking currently occurs on both sides of the carriageway, including across the crest. When vehicles are parked at or near the crest, the effective lane width is reduced, forcing opposing traffic to share the same lane. Therefore, there is a risk of collision between vehicles travelling in opposite directions, particularly with the restricted sightlines due to the crest.

According to the Road Rules 2014, a driver should not stop at or near a crest that restricts adequate sightlines to approaching traffic.

Proposed changes

To address this issue, Council proposes to install 'No Stopping' restrictions across the crest on the western side of the street, with 6m of on-street parking retained adjacent to the driveways of Nos. 6 and 8 to accommodate resident on-street parking requirements. Please refer to the **attached** Plan *MacquarieRd/TDA/112/25*. This will improve sightlines, prevent lane encroachment near and across the crest, and improve safety.
