Dear Resident

Maxwell Street, South Turramurra – Proposed painted island

Council is seeking your input on a proposal to install a painted island, as shown on the **attached** Plan *MaxwellSt/TDA/47/25*.

Background

Council has received correspondence regarding vehicles parking in the space between the driveways of 96 and 98 Maxwell Street. The available space is approximately 2.4m, which is not sufficient to accommodate a standard vehicle without obstructing either driveway. This location is within a bus zone that operates during school morning and afternoon peak periods. Residents have raised concerns that during school events and when the bus zone is not in operation, parents park and leave their vehicles unattended in this area which results in both driveways being blocked.

It has also been observed that the existing double centre lines within the bus zone do not comply with the Road Rules when buses are parked in the area. Under the Road Rules, vehicles must not park within 3m of double centre lines.

Proposed changes

To address this issue, Council proposes to install a painted island in the subject area, as shown in the plan *MaxwellSt/TDA/47/25*. Under Road Rules, a driver is not permitted to park or stop over a painted island. Thus, the installation of the painted island will discourage illegal parking and improve road safety in the area. Furthermore, the existing double centre lines section located within the bus zone will be removed to ensure compliance with the Road Rules.
