Moore Avenue, Lindfield - Proposed Raised Pedestrian Crossing

Council is seeking your input on a proposal to construct a raised pedestrian (Wombat) crossing on Moore Avenue at Bradfield Road.

Background

Council has received a request from the Member for Davidson, on behalf of community members, for a pedestrian crossing to be installed on Moore Avenue opposite the shops in West Lindfield. Council staff have carried out pedestrian counts which show that many people cross Moore Avenue at this location.

Proposed changes

A new raised pedestrian crossing is proposed on Moore Avenue at Bradfield Road. The works would also include an upgrade of the street lighting to meet current standards for a pedestrian crossing, as shown on the **attached** Plan *Moore/KTC/02/26*.

The proposed crossing would provide a safe crossing point for pedestrians wishing to access the local shopping centre. If constructed, this would result in the loss of 1 to 2 on-street parking spaces on the southern side of Moore Avenue.
