Dear Resident,

The Cloisters, St Ives - Proposed 'No Parking' restrictions during daytime.

Council is seeking your input on the proposal to introduce part-time 'No Parking' restrictions during daytime on The Cloisters, St Ives.

Background

Council recently conducted resident consultation regarding the proposal to introduce 'No Parking 8:00am to 4:00pm School Days' restrictions on the side street off The Cloisters.

During the consultation, several concerns were raised by residents. A number of respondents reported ongoing issues with unsafe and frequent parking in the area, particularly during school events held on weekends and holidays. Specific concerns included blocked driveways, limited street access, and serious risks to emergency vehicle access.

Council acknowledges the significance of these concerns and recognises the impact they have on resident safety and amenity.

Proposed changes

To manage parking and traffic in this area, Council is proposing to introduce part-time 'No Parking 8:00am to 6:00pm' restrictions on both The Cloisters and the adjoining side street, as shown in the **attached** Plan No. *Cloisters/TDA85/25*. These restrictions would apply 7 days a week, rather than being limited to school days or hours.

Under this proposal, parking would be prohibited on the eastern side of The Cloisters, the northern side of the side street, as well as within both cul-de-sac turning areas. This arrangement aims to maintain clear access and traffic flow during events held at the school facility, including weekends, public holidays, and school holidays — when parking demand is typically higher.

Additionally, it is proposed to remove the existing 'No Parking 8:00am – 4:00pm School Days' restriction on the western side of The Cloisters. This change would provide five new unrestricted parking spaces, increasing the total number of legal on-street parking spaces on that side to ten.
