Dear Resident

Westbrook Avenue, Wahroonga – Proposed ‘No Stopping’ restriction

Council seeks your input for a proposal to install a "No Stopping" restriction on Westbrook Avenue at the intersection with Endeavour Street, Wahroonga, as shown on the **attached** Plan No. *WestbrookAv/TDA/127/25*.

Background

Council has received correspondence from a resident regarding vehicles parking on Westbrook Avenue within the statutory 10m ‘No Stopping’ distance at the intersection with Endeavour Street. Sightlines for approaching vehicles on Endeavour Street are limited due to trees located on a bend of the intersection, and the uphill gradient on Endeavour Street when approaching the intersection further reduces visibility.

Rumble bars are installed in the centre of the road near the other bend of the intersection, which discourages parking on that side. Sight distance on that side is clear compared to the bend where the trees are located.

Proposed changes

To address this issue, Council proposes to install a ‘No Stopping’ restriction extending beyond the statutory 10m distance at the intersection, due to the sightline obstructions caused by the trees, as shown in the attached Plan No. *WestbrookAv/TDA/127/25*.
