
Tree Fern Gully Walk

Ku-ring-gai Walking Tracks

points of interest

- Spectacular views from Phantom Falls with an approximate drop of 250 metres
- Coachwood gullies provide deep shade and rainforest conditions along sections of both creeks
- Several short turnoffs to picturesque resting spots along the creek
- Change in elevation is depicted in vegetation changes
- A sense of remoteness
- Gates to the Wild Flower gardens are closed at 4pm. Pedestrian exit only after hours.

fire trail and single track walk

- Duration 2.5 hours with rest times
- Degree of difficulty at times this track reaches a Class 4 Hard

Hard:

A distinct track with long steep and rough sections, many steps and stairs and/or frequent difficulties. Low to moderate safety levels. Suitable for people who walk regularly. Visitors with heart or breathing difficulties should not attempt this track.
