Bobbin Head Road Conservation Area

C41 (KLEP 2015)

The Bobbin Head Road Conservation Area is of local heritage significance as a grouping of mostly intact houses from the Federation to Inter-war period. The contributory houses and heritage items within the conservation area are of high quality exhibiting fine detailing and quality workmanship.

The area is of historical significance demonstrating, the history and development of Bobbin Head Road following the break-up of the extensive Robert Pymble estates in 1880s and later. The area represents two phases of development. The southern end of the area, 11-19 Bobbin Head Road, represents the earlier wave of Federation development, with 25-33 Bobbin Head Road being developed in the Inter-war period.
