The new financial year is bringing some opportunities and challenges for our Council.

On the plus side we've completed upgrades to Samuel King Oval at North Turramurra and a facelift for the Fox Valley Road shops at Wahroonga.

We've committed around \$54 million to capital works in this year's budget, which includes new roads, footpaths and drainage.

However like many councils we're facing a funding shortfall due to rate capping. We're currently looking at what can be done to meet this shortfall.

Ku-ring-gai Councillors are your elected representatives. They make decisions on your behalf and will serve the community until Council elections are held in 2024.


